## PSAT/NMSQT Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test

The PSAT/NMSQT is a practice SAT test, which also serves as the qualifying assessment for the National Merit Scholarship Program. To qualify for recognition by the National Merit Scholarship Program, students must be in their third year of high school (junior year) and score in the top 3-5% of all testers.

The PSAT measures critical reading, math reasoning, and writing skills that are important for successful academic performance in college. The test take approximately 2.5 hours to complete and is structured in the same manner as the SAT. The PSAT is recommended for students who are taking advanced or honors classes.

The format for the PSAT has changed this year and will now be a **digital** test, so students should bring their charged Chromebook with them for testing. We will be testing in small groups over multiple days. Student may indicate their preferred date below. All efforts will be made to test students on their preferred date, but spaces will be assigned on a first-come basis. Space is limited to 40 students per test date.
